# Croatian Cultural Centre Covid-19 Safety Plan

Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, the Croatian Cultural Centre has created a Safety Plan for our facility that meets the current requirements in British Columbia. It is very important that we strictly adhere to this plan in order to keep our clients, their patrons and ourselves safe.

\*Please note that we will not share personal health information about employees to our patrons.

# **Employees of the Croatian Cultural Centre**

- Wearing non-medical face coverings when speaking to the patrons is mandatory.
- Wash and Sanitize hands often with the provided hand sanitizer.
- Maintain 6Ft Social Distancing when interacting with customers and other employees of the Centre.
- Complete Covid-19 Self-Assessment before every shift, including temperature check.

### **Clients & Patrons of the Croatian Cultural Centre**

- Physical distancing of 2 meters should be maintained whenever possible between patrons not from the same household.
- Every time before a patron enters the hall, they need to sanitize their hands at the hand sanitizing stations in the lobby.
- If patrons are experiencing any of these symptoms: fever, difficulty breathing, cough, sore throat or headache please stay home.
- The Client must keep a contact-tracing list with names and contact details of all patrons attending the
- Mask use is mandatory again in BC, starting August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021. We have disposable masks available for customers who do not have their own.
- Proof of vaccination is required for gatherings more than 50 ppl as per PHO Order.
- Please see excerpt from Order Of The Provincial Health Officer regarding INSIDE EVENTS for details.
- No gatherings in the lobby, unless patrons are queuing to enter the hall.

## **Facility Maintenance**

- Washrooms will be cleaned daily.
- All common surface areas will be disinfected daily.
- After the event is finished, CCC staff will disinfect all tables and chairs used.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be placed in the lobby along with signs reminding the patrons to wash and sanitize their hands and keep appropriate distances.

#### Excerpt from ORDER OF THE PROVINCIAL HEALTH OFFICER

#### C. INSIDE EVENTS

- 1. A person may permit a place to be used for or may organize or be present at an inside event, if the provisions of this Part and Part D are complied with.
- 2. Up to 100% of the seated operating capacity of a place may be used for the purpose of a seated inside event, and up to 100% of the standing operating capacity of a place may be uses for the purpose of a standing inside event.
- 3. There is an organizer.
- 4. Access to the event is controlled.
- 5. Subject to section 6, if the event is described in paragraph (a), (c), (d) or (e) of the definition of "inside event"
  - (a) There is seating available for each participant, and each participant is providedwith a seat.
  - (b) Participants are seated throughout the place in such a way as to use all availablespace.
- 6. Despite section 5, if the event is described in paragraphs (c), (d) or (e) of the definition of inside event, section 5 only applies to participants who are spectators.
- 7. If there is a food or drink station,
  - a. hand washing facilities or alcohol-based sanitizers are within easy reach of the station;
  - b. signs reminding participants to wash or sanitize their hands before touching self-serve food, drink or other items, are posted at the self-serve station; and

- c. high touch surfaces at the station, and utensils that are used for self- serve, arefrequently cleaned and sanitized.
- 8. Hand sanitation supplies are readily available to participants.
- 9. Toilet facilities with running water, soap and paper towels for hand washing and drying purposes or hand sanitation supplies are available for participants.
- 10. Subject to further direction from me, posted on my website, dance floors are closed withphysical barriers or occupied with tables, unless they are being used for a dance performance.
- 11. A participant must comply with the requirements in this Part and in Part D, and with measures, or guidance or directions from the organizer or a member of staff, intended toavoid the congregation of participants.
- 12. Subject to further direction from me, posted on my website, participants do not dance, unless they are registered participants in and attending at a dance class at a dance studioor a recreation facility. or a child or youth participating in a program for children or youth.
- 13. If there is more than one area in a place in which events may be held, there may be anevent in each of the areas.
- 14. If the organizer is not the owner or occupant of the place in which an inside event is held, the owner or occupant must be satisfied that the organizer is aware of the conditions and requirements in this Part and Part D, and has the capacity to fulfill them.

#### D. PROOF OF VACCINATION

- 1. This Part applies to inside events, and sections 7 and 8 apply to a program forchildren or youth, whether held inside or outside.
- 2. This Part does not apply to
  - i. a person under 12 years of age, or
  - ii. a person 12 to 21 years of age who is participating in a program forchildren or youth or in a sports event.
- 3. The following requirements apply with respect to an inside event:
  - a. An organizer must obtain proof in the form of a vaccine card that a participanthas received two doses of vaccine.
  - b. A participant must provide an organizer with proof in the form of a vaccine

- c. An organizer must not permit a participant who has not provided the organizer with proof in the form of a vaccine card of having received two doses of vaccine to enter or remain a place for the purpose of an event or to participate inan event.
- d. A participant who has not provided an organizer with proof in the form of a vaccine card of having received two doses of vaccine must not enter or remainin a place for the purpose of an event or participate in an event.
- e. If an event takes place on more than one day, the requirements in this sectionapply on each of those days.
- 4. An operator must not scan the QR code on a vaccine card with any tool other than aBC Vaccine Card Verifier App.
- 5. Subject to section 6, an organizer must not retain proof of vaccination or identification provided by a participant, or use it for any purpose other than to confirm that a participant has been vaccinated, as required by this Order.
- 6. Despite section 5, with the written consent of a participant, an organizer may keep a record of the fact that the participant has provided proof of being vaccinated in compliance with this Part until this Order expires or is repealed, and the organizer may rely upon this record to satisfy the requirements in this Part with respect to future participation by the participant in an event at the same place.
- 7. An adult must have received two doses of vaccine if the adult is leading, supervisingor assisting with a program for children or youth, whether the program takes place inside or outside.
- 8. An adult who had not received two doses of vaccine must not lead, supervise or assist with a program for children or youth, whether the program takes place insideor outside.
